2024 HTCA FUTURITY CHAMPION

Winning the 2024 HTCA Futurity with Dagley's Flash was a déjà vu experience according to breeder/owner/trainer/handler David Dagley. He states she is very similar to her sire, Dagley Ranch bred & trained HTCA Supreme 2022 Futurity Champion Dagley's Mr. Tucket. Both father & daughter share a high desire to please and an eagerness to learn, mixed with natural control. From her first time on sheep as a young pup, Dagley noticed something unique about his pup. Flash cared more about controlling livestock, rather than the typical puppy response to rush to create movement in the flock. Flash's innate patience came balanced with a desire to quickly read and counter the animals she was working. These natural instincts carried all through her training and into HTCA competition. Trust was inspired between both trainer & dog, when Flash would allow her inborn herding instincts to gather & hold, to be overridden to follow Dagley's commands instead. She had complete faith in her trainer, even when it did not

Hangin' Tree Maturity Champion Redstick's Rainbow continued her winning ways in 2024. Bred and owned by Redstick Cowdogs, Rainbow was trained and handled by Jared Lee Lewis, who bred and handled her dam Midnight before Gary Sullivan of Redstick bought Midnight for his breeding program.

Rainbow cut her teeth in a versatile career scoring Reserve champion of a multiple breed sheep dog futurity trial before getting serious at the 2022 HTCA World Trials to win the Hangin' Tree Futurity Championship. She was HTCA Horseback Reserve Champion in 2022 as well on a challenging course for a young dog that started with a blind fetch. Additionally Redstick's Rainbow has significant non HTCA sanctioned earnings including proudly representing for the Hangin' Tree breed at open Cowdog events against multiple breeds.

Handler/trainer Jared Lee Lewis says Rainbow's thought process set her apart even as a pup. From the start she always worked stock with a specific purpose in mind, never chaotically. No matter if she worked sheep or cattle, Rainbow calibrated herself to just the level of pressure needed to shape the stock. She is very good about waiting on a command, then going to stock and quietly asking them to move, but she does not hesitate to use as persuasive a level of aggression as necessary.

Rainbow's busy schedule has included raising 2 litters of pups that are currently starting well. She wasted no time post partum getting back in shape-Jared counts on her making a hand as he frequently does day work. Lewis says Rainbow's personality lends to being a good family dog too that will scent track or play any game including dock diving and baseball by fetching balls for the pitcher.

Rainbow will not be taking maternity leave in 2025 so she can

necessarily make sense from a cowdog's point of view. Flash quickly learned to be comfortable in positions she would not have chosen if not commanded to do so. Dagley reports he was originally hesitant to enter his dog in the Futurity since she was so young and she would be at a disadvantage competing at only 17 months of age. By comparison, the average age of all the futurity entries in 2024 was 22 months old. Although Dagley's ranch work commitments prevented him from working his young dog as consistently as he would have preferred, the 45 lb. blue merle female's ability to calmly but firmly handle cattle and her quickness to learn saved a lot of training time. Mentally she was exceptionally mature to the point of thinking like an aged dog. Eventually Flash's trainability and exceptionally fast progress convinced Dagley to commit to pay the late penalty and enter up. Dagley credits Flash's innate cattle handling instincts with helping him navigate to success through the HTCA Futurity Trials. The young dog's decisions consistently navigated the cattle through the obstacles with minimal resistance, perhaps quicker and more efficiently than Dagley himself could have reacted and commanded her. The dam of Daalev's Flash is Kimberly's Smudge (OCC Hobo x OCC Bailey), owned by Kimberly Karch. Smudge was bred by Ogden Cattle Co. and comes from generations of the Oaden Ranch's working Hangin' Tree Cowdogs. Although Smudge was never trialed, Dagley became familiar with the dog when owner Kimberly approached him for training advice and assistance getting her dog permanently registered. Smudge responded so well to minimal training she impressed Dagley and he realized she should cross well with his good stud dog Dagley's Mr. Tucket. Karch agreed and the mating has produced excellent results...Flash has banked \$4957.20 in her first competition! In 2025, Flash will continue to be used regularly for general ranch work, particularly as a role model for Dagley's younger Hangin' Tree Cowdog prospects. Puppies of her own are in Flash's long-term future as well.

RESERVE CHAMPION TRAYER'S SAVAGE SAM

2018 HTCA Futurity Champion Supreme Trayer's Savage Sam racked up yet another achievement with a Reserve title in the 2024 HTCA Maturity. Bred in the purple by Charlie Trayer, he is both sired by, and out of Hangin' Tree Supreme certified parents. Sam is a son of 2016 Stud Dog of the Year Hangin Judge Bean (Judge won the first Hangin' Tree Futurity ever held, although that was an unofficial event put together as a mutual challenge by Hangin' Tree handlers at the time.) Sam's dam Trayer's Pepper won both go rounds and the finals enroute to becoming HTCA's 1st official Futurity Champion (2015). Without batting an eye Pepper whelped Sam in 2016, then went on to earn Championship buckles as the HTCA Horseback Champion (2017), and the HTCA Supreme Reserve Champion title (2019). Pepper's son Sam has passed on the winning gene pool. Sam is the sire of HTCA Maturity Champion Trayer's Blue (2021), two HTCA Futurity Reserve Champions-Clementine's Kalil (2021) and Hazel Red (2020) as well as siring 3 Supreme certified dogs-Dagle's Stoney, Trayer's Blue, & Trayer's Axle.

As a small pup, Charlie sold Sam to long time client National Cutting Horse Association Million Dollar Rider and NCHA Hall of Famer Tate Bennett. Bennett has bought many Hangin' Tree Cowdog prospects off Charlie over the years. Charlie describes Tate as a heck of a hand with both Cutters and Cowdogs. Tate kept calling Charlie almost weekly to brag on how outstanding Sam was. Finally, Tate brought the pup

back to show him to Charlie when Sam was about a year old. When Tate got back in his truck to head home from Charlie's, it was with a check in the place of the blue merle pup. Turns out it was a good investment-as a sire, Sam has produced as strong and consistently as he works. Charlie goes on record stating Sam is the fastest dog he has ever worked, also exceptionally intelligent, and extremely trainable. Sam has been a perennial cattle trial champion as well as a true asset working countless cattle over the years.

Redstick's Whip handled by Jared Lee Lewis by HTCA Supreme ZR Batman x HTCA Supreme Daphne (by Trayer's Jackson)

When trainer Jared Lewis Lee and Redstick Cowdoa's Gary Sullivan Sr. agreed to breed Lee's HTCA Supreme certified dog Batman to Sullivan's Supreme certified Dafne, Lee got Redstick's Whip to train from the cross. The red merle male showed strong promise when he was started on sheep at about 5 months old and trained up easily despite Lee getting behind when his home and training facility suffering extensive damage during Hurricane Helene. Lee felt his dog was not quite ready due to Jared having to divert time to emergency repairs to his facility from storm damage but states Whip performed well in the Futurity trials regardless of time lost.

Lee says Whip is comparable to sire
Batman-they are both strong, driven,
explosive dogs with big motors that give
110%. In 2025 Lee will be continuing to using
Whip for general ranch work 2-3x/per week
along with trial preparation.

Tailgate talk: ASK THE CHAMPIONS

What is the best Cowdog training advice you've ever heard or given?

- Herman Cook: "Be firm, but fair."
- David Dagley: "Your dog cannot disobey you if you do not give it a command. Pick your battles.....ONLY give a command when you are committed to enforcing your dog to follow through. Teach your dog strict obedience."
- Jared Lee Lewis: "Get your dog to listen TO you...not FOR you." (quoting Bobby Dykes)
- Charlie Trayer: "Do not let bad habits get started.
- It is much easier to prevent a bad habit than it is to cure one after a dog acquires it."
